More recently, there has been interest in the function of micronutrient imbalances in oral and other inflammatory illnesses, which are observed in a variety of systemic inflammatory diseases. Minerals and vitamins, many of which are antioxidants, are micronutrients that have been shown to regulate inflammatory responses. Additionally, the composition of the oral microbiome has been discovered to be influenced by diet, and this has been indirectly connected to an increased risk of dental illnesses.
